In the past few months there has been a huge amount of work done to move towards this goal. Becoming Australia's First Bottled Water Free Town is yet another example of what our magnificent community can achieve.

The *Bundy on Tap* working group, a committee of the Bundanoon Community Association, has worked closely with our local business community which is giving overwhelming support to the initiative, recognizing the positive benefits from the plan. Additionally Bundanoon Public School and our major events such as Brigadoon and The Highland Fling are all ready to go 'bottled water free'.

The idea is that all Bundanoon shops, cafes and events currently selling or giving away single use still bottled water will stop doing so and that filtered tap water will be widely available in the town via stylish new public 'water stations', in-store chilled, filtered water units and refillable Bundy on Tap bottles

(like bike bottles). As part of this we have already secured 3 sponsored 'water stations' worth \$18000 for the town including one for the school.

At the 8 July meeting hear about the plans and ask all the questions you might have. The 8 July Community Meeting is vital to gain your support for this exciting initiative and to show your support for those businesses at the front line of the initiative

At the meeting you'll have the chance to:

- ~ Hear Huw Kingston outline the idea of going Bottled Water Free and the plans to make it happen. Huw is the organizer of The Highland Fling and owner of Ye Olde Bicycle Shoppe.
- ~ Hear special guest Jon Dee inspire all with why this plan is so important, the issues around bottled water and why Bundanoon going bottled water free will offer huge business and community benefits. Jon is the founder of Do Something (see www.dosomething.net.au). He was also the founder, of Planet Ark, was behind Coles Bay becoming Australia's first plastic bag free town and was behind Manly Council's decision to ban bottled water from its facilities and place bubblers around the council area. Jon also put together the recent Channel 9, 60 Minutes programme on Bottled Water.
- ~ Hear Peter Stewart from the Bundanoon Newsagency on why local businesses see this as a positive boost.
