'Bundy-on-Tap' official launch – Bundanoon goes bottled water free

At a town hall meeting in July, Bundanoon residents voted 355 to 1 in favour of stopping the sale of still bottled water. It created a global firestorm of publicity for the small NSW town.

On **Saturday 26 September 2009**, Bundanoon's switchover will be complete and the initiative will formally be launched in this beautiful Southern Highlands town. It will make Bundanoon the first town in Australia, if not the world, to go bottled water free.

On that day, the very last bottle of still water will be pulled off shelf and the new hi-tech filtered water stations will be turned on in the main street and school. These will provide people with free of charge filtered water.

'Bundy on Tap' reusable bottles and chilled filtered water will also be available for sale in-store. These moves will ensure that residents and visitors will always have access to great drinking water – but without the environmental price of bottled water.

Launch proceedings commence at 10am at the Bundanoon Memorial Hall. You are invited to come and join the big switch!
